Boise is blessed to have the variety and quality of an amazing performing arts community. ARTS & CULTURE - MAIN VENUES

BOISE CENTRE ON THE GROVE - 850 W. Front St. Boise. Boise Center is Idaho's largest convention center facility, and Boise's premier meeting facility. Located in the heart of downtown Boise's shopping, restaurants, hotels, and nightlife, all within easy walking distance. PH. 208-336-8900. www.boisecentre.com. Downtown Map G-5

EGYPTIAN THEATRE - 700 W. Main. First built in 1927, and beautifully restored in 1999, the theatre is a regular movie house, but is also used for special events, including performances by Opera Idaho. Well worth a visit. Downtown Map I-4

THE ESTHER SIMPLOT PERFORMING ARTS ACADEMY - South 9th Street. Serves primarily as a performance, rehearsal, and recital facility for many of the local performing arts groups. Downtown Map G-7

EXTRAMILE ARENA - Located on the campus of BSU, this 12,600seat multipurpose arena is one of two facilities that serve the needs of Boise Valley. Boise Valley Map L-7

FULTON STREET THEATRE - Fulton Street. An intimate 220-seat theatre in a beautifully renovated former seed warehouse, it serves as the primary venue for Boise Contemporary Theatre. Downtown Map F-7

IDAHO CENTRAL ARENA - Attached to the Grove Hotel in Downtown Boise, the arena often stages a variety of shows and concerts, and is home to the Idaho Steelheads Ice Hockey Team. Downtown Map H-5

JUMP (JACKS URBAN MEETING PLACE) - Downtown Boise BODO. This lasting legacy pays tribute to Idaho's icon, J.R. Simplot. A major addition to the special event and meeting venues in Boise, JUMP is a major addition to the arts and culture landscape of Boise. Downtown Map F-6

THE VELMA V. MORRISON CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS (MORRISON CENTER) - located on the BSU Campus, alongside the Boise River, the center is recognized as being one of the finest performing arts facilities in the nation, and often plays host to major touring productions, along with locally produced performances. Boise Valley Map K-7

VISUAL ARTS COLLECTIVE - Located in the Alley Arts & Cultural District, in Garden City, it serves as a mixed-use contemporary venue. Boise Valley Map J-6

ATTRACTIONS

AQUARIUM OF BOISE - 64 N. COLE RD., BOISE. Located on the corner of Franklin and Cole roads. The Aquarium of Boise provides for both learning and fun for all ages through large scale saltwater tanks of colorful tropical fish, sharks, rays and much more, including reptiles. BOISE DEPOT - South end of Capitol Blvd. One of the best views of the city are from the Platt Gardens in front of this wonderful mission style depot built in 1925. **Boise Valley Map K-7**

IDAHO ANN FRANK HUMAN RIGHTS MEMORIAL - South end of 8th Street. Featuring a life-size bronze sculpture of Ann Frank, a reading circle, two reflecting ponds, three waterfalls, in an amphitheater setting. Downtown Map H-9

IDAHO BOTANICAL GARDEN - 2355 Old Penitentiary Road, Boise. Old Idaho Penitentiary grounds. Boise Valley Map M-7

IDAHO STATE CAPITOL BUILDING - Capitol Blvd. & Jefferson. A mini version of our nation's capital building. The only Statehouse in the country geothermally heated. Downtown Map H-1

MK NATURE CENTER - 600 S. Walnut. (Idaho Fish & Game). A fascinating creation of a "Living River" viewed through a series of windows. Boise Valley Map M-7

MEMORIAL ROSE GARDEN - Julia Davis Park. With over 2,000 rose bushes, and over 200 varieties, this is the sweetest "smelling" spot in Boise. A must visit for all flower lovers. **Downtown Map J-9**

O'FARRELL CABIN - Outside the entrance to Military Reserve Park. Although somewhat nondescript, and off the beaten path, this obscure little structure is quite significant as it is thought to be the city's first permanent residence. It was also the first place of catholic worship in Boise. **Boise** Valley Map L-6

OLD IDAHO PENITENTIARY - 2445 OLD PENITENTIARY ROAD, BOISE. East end of Warm Springs Ave. Built in 1870, and operated till 1973, the Old Idaho Pen housed over 13,000 prisoners. One of only three still in existence today. Tours are available. Call for times. PH. 208-334-2844. www.history.idaho.gov. Boise Valley Map N-7

ZOO BOISE - Julia Davis Park. Featuring over 300 animals from 100 various species. The Petting Zoo is a big hit with the kids. Downtown Map M-8

HISTORIC AREAS/DISTRICTS

BASQUE BLOCK - Grove Street between 6th & Capitol. Anchored by the Basque Museum & Boarding House, and the Basque Market across the street, it is also the site of several well-preserved buildings. A lively spot for downtown Boise, especially on a Wednesday, during "Alive After Five." Downtown Map I-4

BODO DISTRICT - 8th & Broad St. Once the warehouse district, most of the buildings have been renovated and preserved to house an edectic mix of shopping, dining and retail. **Downtown Map G-6**

HARRISON BOULEVARD - This tree lined boulevard boasts some the finest stately old homes in Boise (Many listed on the National Historic Register), and is well worth taking a drive through or a leisurely stroll. Boise Valley Map L-5

HISTORIC OLD BOISE - 6TH & MAIN. DOWNTOWN BOISE. Once the core for Downtown Boise, the Old Boise area is now a popular destination for food, fun, shopping and nightlife, and showcases most of the well-preserved buildings in downtown Boise. www.oldboise.com. Downtown Map K-4

HYDE PARK - 13th Street. The heart of Boise's historic North End neighborhood. Once a thriving commercial district, served by trolley service, the Hyde Park District is a favorite destination for "Northenders" and locals alike. Lots of great little shops and restaurants. **Boise Valley Map L-5**

WARM SPRINGS AVENUE - Beautiful Victorian style mansions line both sides of the avenue, many of which were owned and occupied by the "Who's Who" of Boise. Notably, most of the homes were heated by geothermal springs, as was The Boise Natatorium, a nationally acclaimed indoor aquatic center, once situated at the east end of Warm Springs Avenue. **Boise Valley Map M-7**

MUSEUMS & CULTURAL CENTERS

BASQUE MUSEUM & CULTURAL CENTER - Downtown "Old" Boise. Visit the original Basque boarding house and view exhibits that show the impact the Basque culture had on Boise. Be sure to stop by the Basque Market for unique Basque offerings and delicious food. www.basquemuseum.eus Downtown Map J-5

BOISE ART MUSEUM - Julia Davis Park. Be sure to visit Idaho's only public art museum. More than 15 exhibitions are featured annually. Downtown Map J-9

DISCOVERY CENTER OF IDAHO - 131 Myrtle Street. This is a "Hands On" and interactive museum with over 150 exhibits, that make learning fun for the entire family. Downtown Map N-7

IDAHO BLACK HISTORY MUSEUM - Housed in the historic St. Paul's Baptist Church, Julia Davis Park. Showcasing historical photos, crafts and artifacts representative of Idaho's diverse black cultural heritage. Call ahead for times as they are not always open. **Downtown Map K-8**

IDAHO MILITARY MUSEUM - 4692 W. HARVARD ST, [Next to Gowen Field]. Established in 1995. See and learn how Idahoans from the Army, Navy, Marines and Air Force impacted military history. Displays feature the development of Gowen field, the General Patch WW1 collection, along with Idaho's naval history. Attractions include: Aircraft, tanks, armored vehicles, special exhibits on World War 11, the Vietnam War, the Spanish-American War and others, a vintage PT-23 WW11-era trainer and an F-4 Cockpit simulator, weapons, uniforms and other artifacts dating back to the early 20th century, and a tribute to Idaho's medal of honor recipients. IDAHO MUSEUM OF MINING & GEOLOGY - Old Idaho Penitentiary. Artifacts and photography of Idaho's early mining days, along with exhibits of spectacular geographical features. Boise Valley Map N-7

IDAHO STATE MUSEUM - LOCATED IN JULIA DAVIS PARK. The story of Idaho from its prehistoric time through its pioneer settlement. Displays also include Native American, Basque, and Chinese history. PH. 208-334-2120. www.history.idaho.gov/museum. Downtown Map J-8

PARKS

For a city Its size, Boise has an amazing system of parks and recreational opportunities. The following are some of Boise's major parks. for a complete list of facilities, go to www.cityofboise.org

ANN MORRISON PARK - Boise's oldest and largest park. Features include athletic fields, picnic facilities, playgrounds, and a lighted fountain. A great place to recreate and relax. **Boise Valley Map K-7**

BARBER PARK - Located approximately 6 miles upstream from Downtown Boise, this county park is the major launch area for rafting and tubing down the Boise River. **Boise Valley Map O-9**

CHERI BUCKNER-WEBB PARK. 1100 W. Bannock Street, this Is a welcome "Urban Park" addition to the C.W Moore Park. Downtown Map E-3

C.W. MOORE PARK - A tiny urban park nestled at 5th & Grove. Check out one of the few working water wheels from days gone by. Downtown Map K-4

ESTHER SIMPLOT PARK - This extensive 55-acre park encompasses approximately 23 acres of ponds perfect for swimming, wading, paddle boarding, and fishing. Trails, docks, wetlands, boardwalks, shelters, playgrounds, and restrooms. Boise's most recent addition, the park is located at 614 N. Whitewater Park Blvd. **Boise Valley Map K-5**

HYATT HIDDEN LAKES RESERVE - As the name implies, this hidden gem is a 44-acre haven for birds, animals and humans alike. The wildlife habitat is located on the edge of Boise's West Bench. Boise Valley Map H-4

J.A. AND KATHRYN ALBERTSON FAMILY FOUNDATION BOISE WHITEWATER PARK (WHITEWATER PARK)- This \$3.6 million park features two state-of-the-art wave shapers, attracting both kayakers, boaters and spectators who have discovered the fun of surfing the waves. The Park is located at 3900 W. Pleasanton Ave. (Access is from Whitewater Park Blvd.) Boise Valley Map J-5

JULIA DAVIS PARK - This beautiful 90-acre park is the crown jewel of the Boise Park System, and has it all. it is also the site for The Boise Art Museum, The Idaho State Historical Museum, the Memorial Rose Garden, and Zoo Boise. Downtown Map M-8

KATHRYN ALBERTSON PARK - Located across Americana Blvd. from Ann Morrison Park, this passive botanical garden and wildlife preserve is perfect for strolling and enjoying nature. A favorite spot for photographers and wedding parties. **Boise Valley Map K-6**

KRISTIN ARMSTRONG PARK - Walnut Street, off Warm Springs Ave. Also, home to Idaho Fish & Game, the park is bordered by the Boise River. A beautiful setting and local favorite for picnics and family gatherings. The site has quite a storied history, which can be read on several information displays throughout the park. **Boise Valley Map M-7**

LUCKY PEAK STATE PARK - Located just 8 miles east of Boise, this is a popular summer destination for boating, water skiing, and sailing. There's a great swimming spot below Lucky Peak Dam at Sandy Point. **Boise** Valley Map P-10

MARIANNE WILLIAMS PARK - A beautiful 72-acre site located on the Boise River in East Boise's Barber Valley. Boise Valley Map N-9

MILITARY RESERVE PARK - Located at Fort and Reserve Streets, this 466-acre park is home to the Veterans Hospital, and the Old Boise Barracks. Excellent hiking trails and views of the city. **Boise Valley** Map M-6 VETERANS MEMORIAL STATE PARK - Nestled between State Street and the Boise River, walk amongst 100-year-old cedar trees, and stroll along the banks of the Boise River. **Boise** Valley Map J-5
